




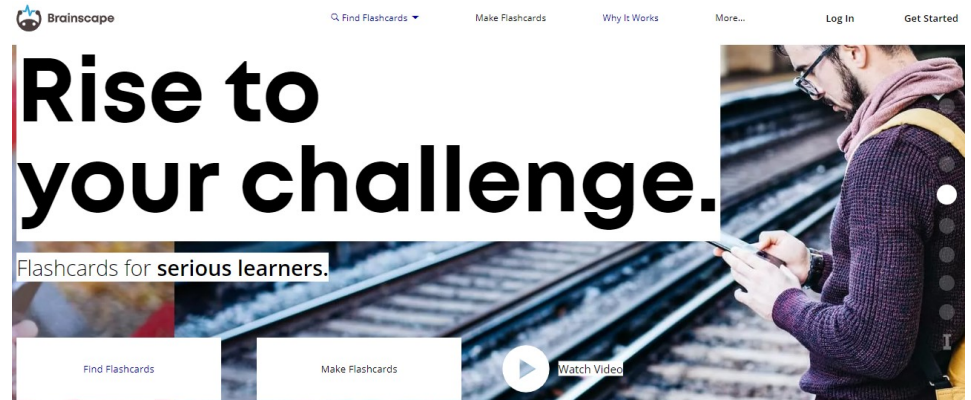

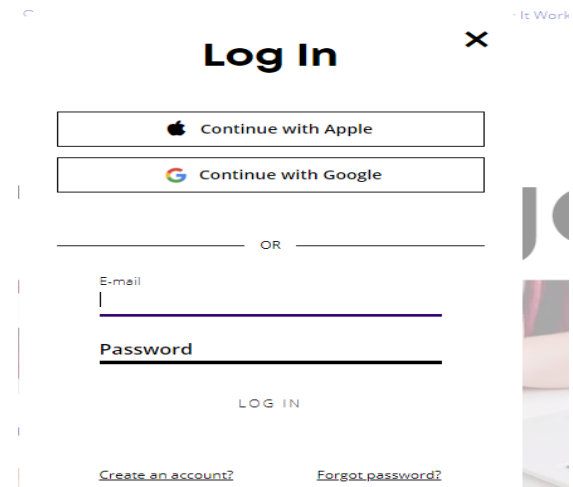

1. Go to the website: Brainscape.com



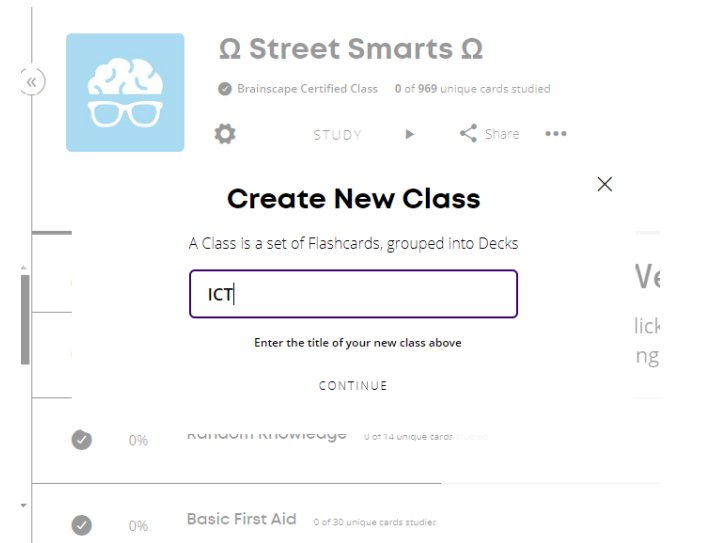
2. Click 'Log-In' and sign in with your apple or Gmail account, or simply create a new account.



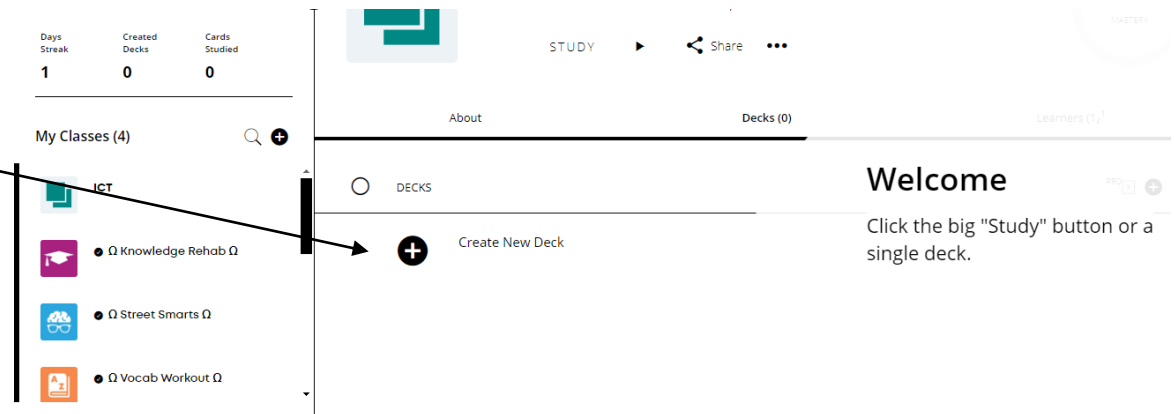


PREPARE THE ACTIVITY

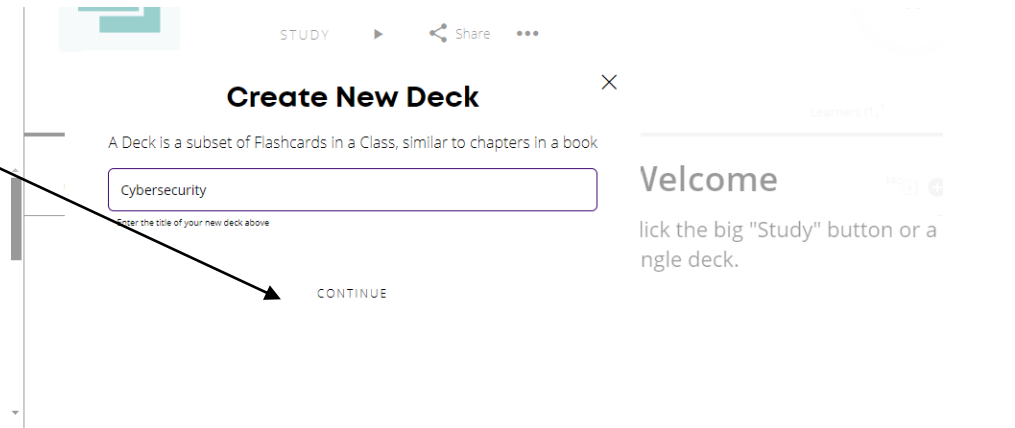
1. Go to your dashboard and select the option 'Create a class'.



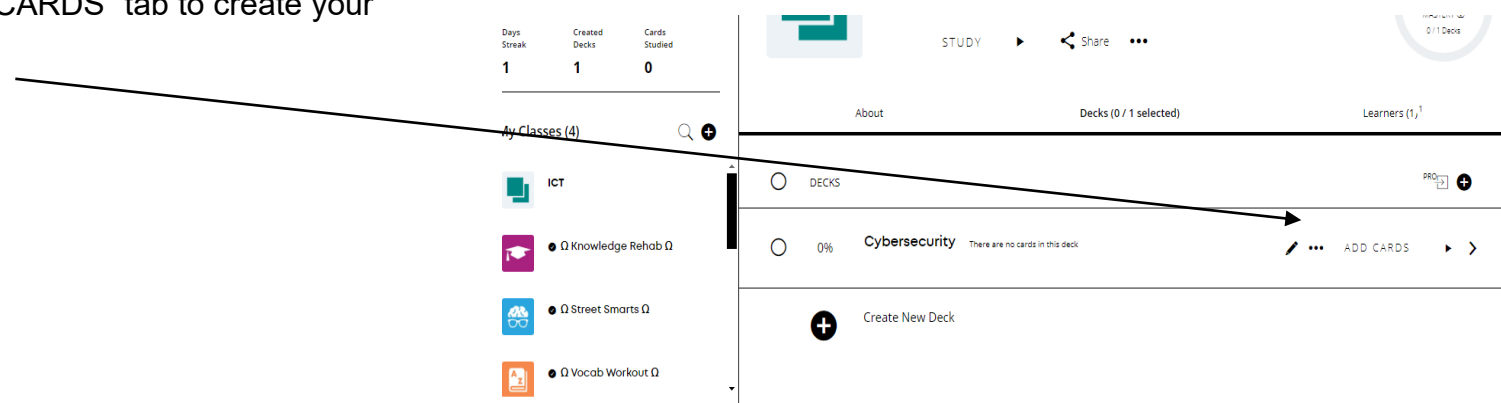
2. Click on "Create New Deck" option.




3. Give a title to your deck and click “continue”.




4. Click on the “ADD CARDS” tab to create your flashcards.



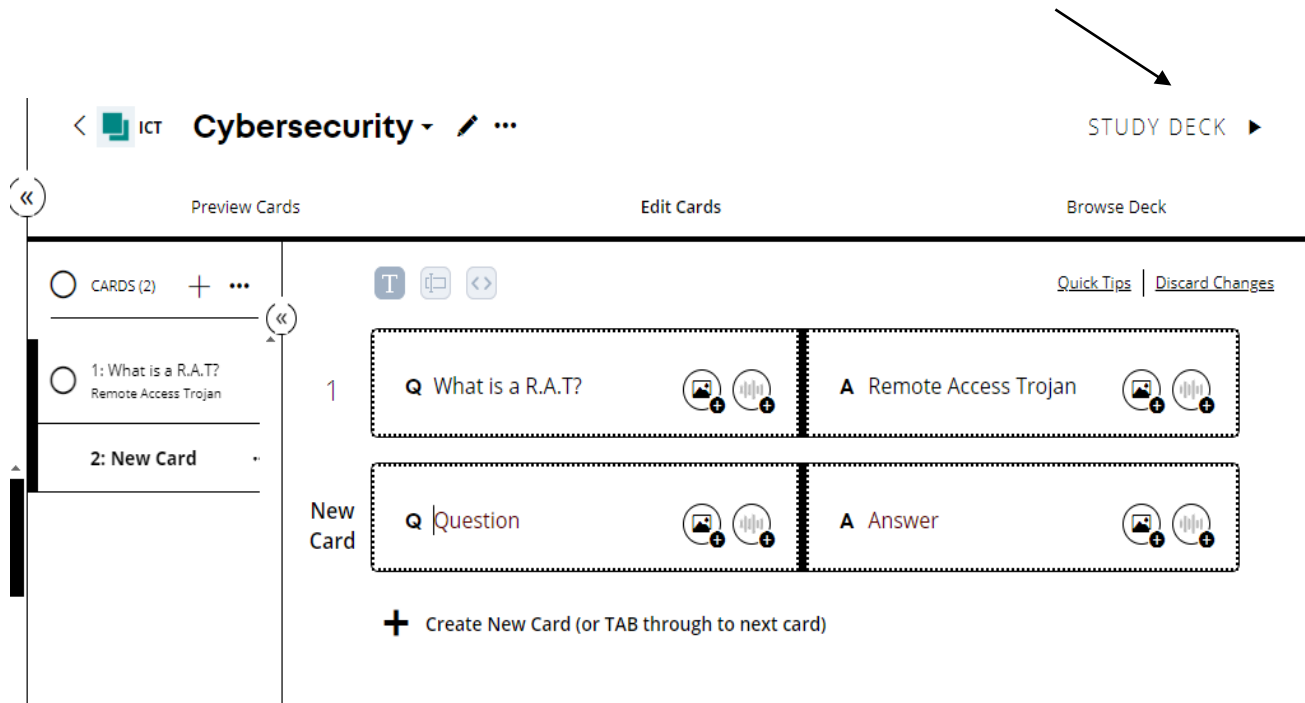
5. Type in the question and answer for the flashcard.




