SAVE AND PUBLISH

- 1. To share the deck of created phishes, click the three dots in the upper right corner.
- Click "SHARE" and when a new window appears, add the name of the study group and the participants in that group by entering their email addresses.
- 3. After adding the email addresses, click "SHARE".
- 4. To the e-mail addresses of the participants, will come the information that a deck of "Waste Management" fiches has been made available to them and that this deck will appear in the "Shared decks" section the next time you launch the AnkiApp.
