





STEPS – GETTING STARTED

1. Go to spiderscribe.net, create an account, log in.
2. Start with button NEW, and chose Map.




PREPARE THE ACTIVITY


1. Using icons on the left side add elements of the diagram you want to create.



2. Drag the selected item to the right, then add the text, photo or file.
3. At the bottom of each element with text, there is a '+' to connect the elements in the diagram.





4. Create and connect main categories and then add elements with different human rights – students will match them (it is task for them).
5. Using the button at the right top (Stencil Properties) you can change the colour of background of the elements with text.





SAVE AND PUBLISH

1. Using button SHARE you can get the link to your map and send it to your students (put the link in the mission in GooseChase), using EDIT add emails of your students – they will be able to edit the map and connect items (categorize human rights into generations).
