GRADE AND SUBJECT: For all educational levels. Although Quizlet is mainly dedicated to learning foreign languages, particularly vocabulary, it can also be used for other subjects that require knowledge and memorization of notions or specific vocabulary.

SHORT DESCRIPTION: Quizlet is a free web app that allows the creation of tests, quizzes, flashcards, and games to make learning and reviewing fun and challenging.

READING TIME: 4 minutes

LEARNING GOALS: It is not always easy for teachers to find the right method to make students learn and memorize information and concepts, especially in the case of students with specific learning disorders. Quizlet helps teachers support and engage students with interactive material, study sets and classroom games.

MOMENTS OF NEED OF THE TOOL: Quizlet is a very useful tool for learning and memorizing new notions and concepts, and for reviewing and testing those already learned.

WHY USE THIS TOOL: Quizlet is a tool that allows teachers to create quizzes and flashcards for face-to-face or distance learning, making creation and assessment quick and easy. It also makes it possible to create customized learning by adapting it to the students' needs. Quizlet offers a wide range of subjects and question styles, from visual study materials to fill-in-the-blanks games and more. According to Quizlet, 90% of students who use it report higher grades.

TOOL DESCRIPTION: Quizlet is a free web app that offers a variety of teaching methods and materials, study sets and classroom games. It is an efficient and effective tool to study different subjects, such as languages, algebra, etc., through flashcard study sets of content. These study sets help to engage students in-class activities and support them in their studies at home. Also, Quizlet allows to search existing sets, copy, and customize them by changing definitions, adding images or terms, etc.

PREPARATION AND HOW TO USE THE TOOL: It is possible to start using Quizlet online by creating an account without having to install any application. Once registered, it is possible to search for content created by others or create your content. Quizlet allows users to create study "sets" of information and learning resources that are lists of terms paired with their matching definitions or a set of questions with their matching answers. Moreover, Quizlet allows images to be associated with the text, and to listen to the content of flashcards in numerous languages thanks to voice synthesis. In addition to traditional testing tools (true and false, multiple answers, quizzes), Quizlet offers several games such as scatter, space race or gravity.
