
#### **STEPS – GETTING STARTED**

- 1. Go to the website mystorybook.com
- 2. Click on "Get started" to sign up for a new account or log in if you already have one.





3. Once you are in, create your story book by clicking the "Create a StoryBook" button, on the left.







# PREPARE THE ACTIVITY

1. Choose a title for your story and write a short description.




2. Choose a Scene for your book, the background colour can be changed.



3. Choose the Items for your book. There is a wide variety: you can choose from your own images, but there are also many other

options.





- 4. Click on the "People" button to add characters. Use your imagination and create characters by selecting the option which are offered (skin tone, hair colour and style, face, accessories, body, clothing, etc.).
- 5. Add Page and continue Writing your story in the story text box, choose the background, items and people for each page.







# **SAVE AND PUBLISH**

1. After you finish writing, click the "DONE EDITING" button on the top right.

2. Share your story book: Click the Sharing box and share your story copying the link and then, paste it on different platforms.


