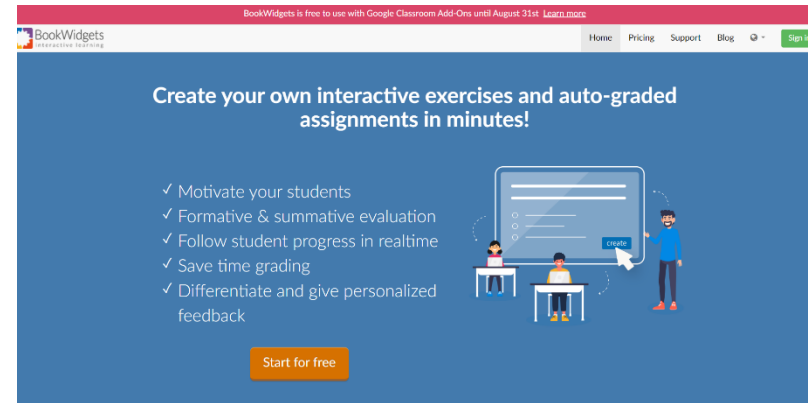

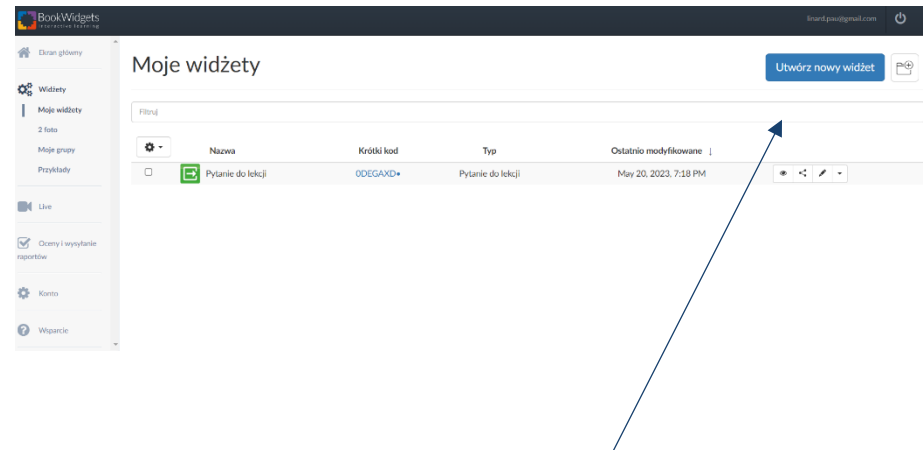


STEPS – GETTING STARTED

1. Go to the website [Bookwidgets](https://bookwidgets.com)



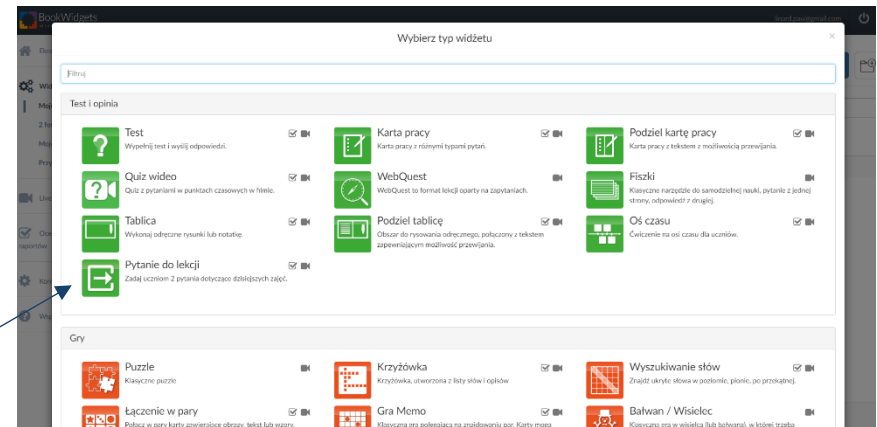
2. Sign in (eg. using your gmail account) and click the blue “create” button on the right side.



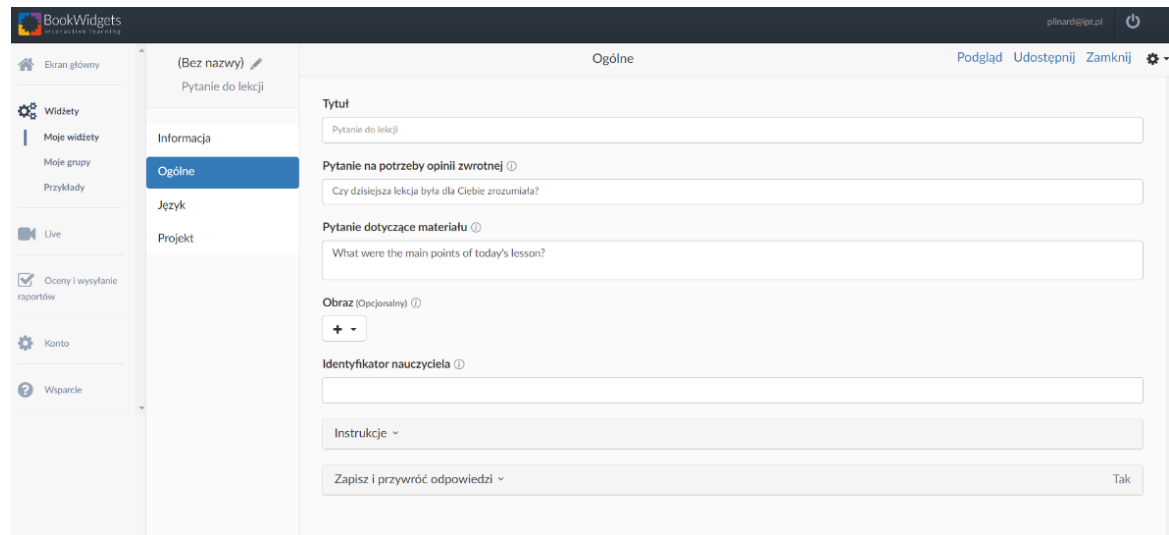


PREPARE THE ACTIVITY

1. Choose the type of widget – questions for the lesson.



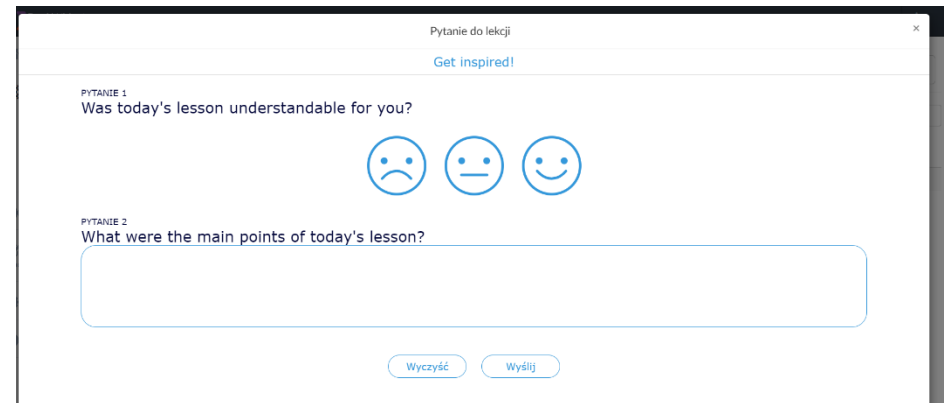
2. Write the title of the lesson, question for feedback (Was today's lesson understandable for you?) and material question (What were the main points of today's lesson?).



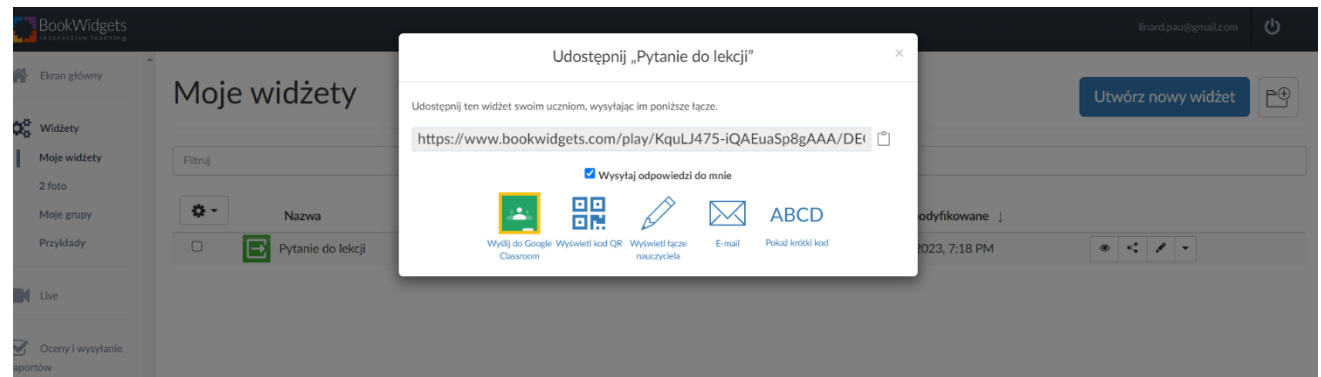


SAVE AND PUBLISH

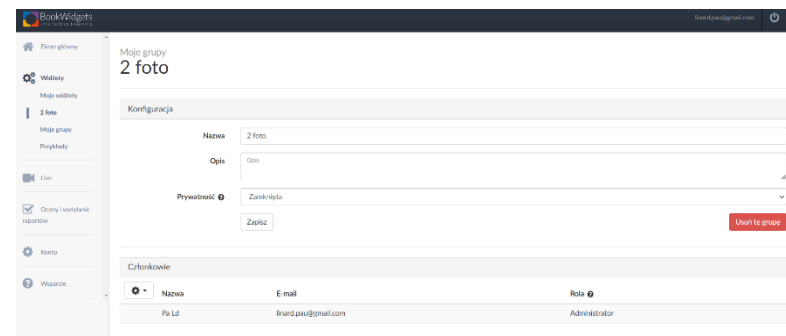
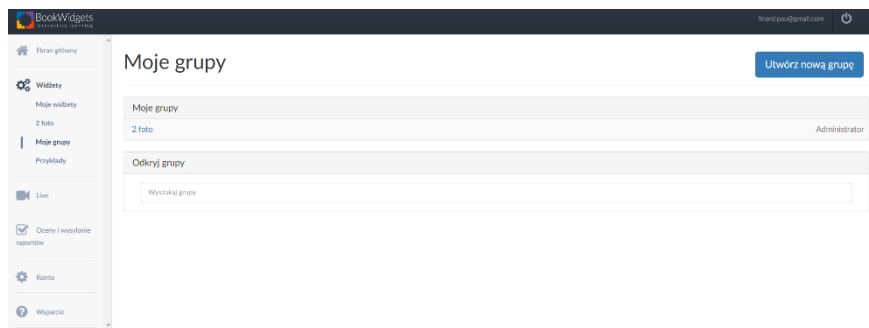
1. Click Preview to see your widget – you can see the student's view.



2. Click Share to get the link or QR code for your students.

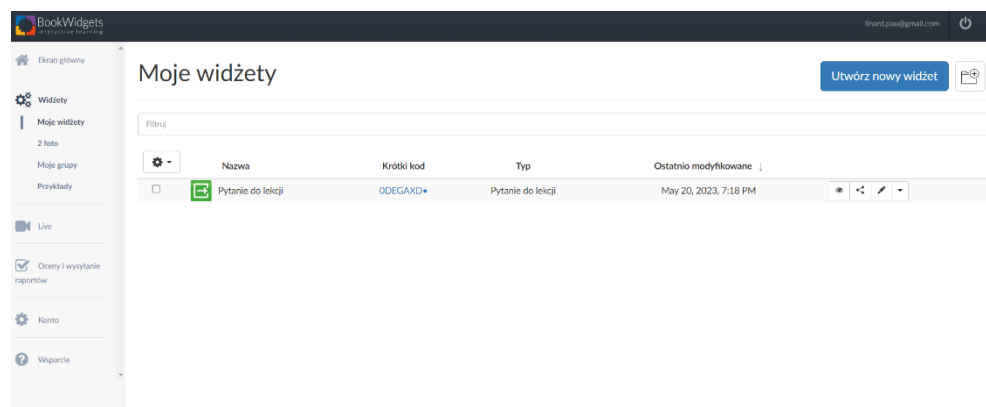


3. You can also add the group(s) and invite your students than you can share with them widgets, surveys, tasks – you should use menu at the left – choose the good option and than Create at the right top.

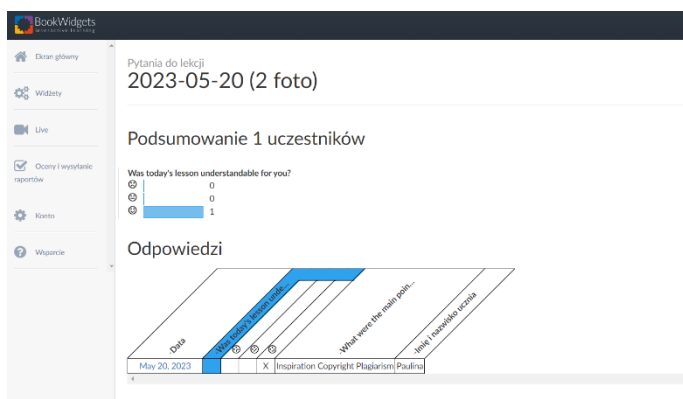
